This Competition will be held as part of the 2016 Charleville Performing Arts Festival on the 1st - 3rd September at the Charleville Racecourse Complex. Through the uniquely engaging medium of storytelling, this competition aims to raise awareness within our community about the damage feral pigs create in local environments.

Participants must orally present a story which addresses the damage caused by feral pigs, or how domestic pigs become pests when they are released or abandoned in the wild.

Stories can be serious, funny, fact, or complete fiction - **let your imagination run WILD!**
