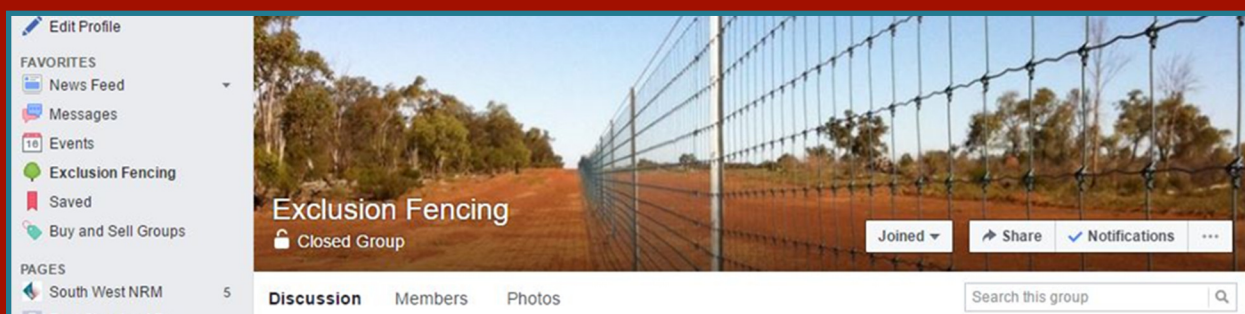


Exclusion Fencing Meets Facebook!
