If you have an interest in undertaking a new project for the 2017-18 financial year, keep an eye out on the South West NRM website from 1 July 2017.

Applications are sought for the following areas:

- Pest fish removal,
- Wild dog trapping,
- Fencing of sensitive areas in the landscape,
- Managing total grazing pressure,
- Protecting endangered species,
- Watering points to improve grazing management,
- Removal of isolated weeds such as Hudson Pear, Coral Cactus, Parthenium, Mesquite, Prickly Acacia, Harissa Cactus, Mother of Millions, Pencil Willow,
- Interest in release of biological control bugs for Coral Cactus,
- Feral pig and cat removal, plus
- Projects that deliver on other aspects of the South West NRM Regional Plan ([click here](#) to access a copy of our Regional Plan).

The target areas are the Bulloo, Warrego, Paroo, and Nebine River catchments. Targeted mapping will be available on our website to indicate project priority areas. All projects will need to begin promptly, and be completed during the 2017/18 financial year.
