## TOPICS COVERED:

- Weeds of National Significance (WoNS) found in the South West NRM region.
- Weed ecology.
- Surveillance and early detection methods with appropriate mapping.
- Class 1 and 2 weed identification.
- New Biosecurity Act being implemented from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2016.
- How to collect and preserve weed specimens for identification.
- On ground treatment processes for effective herbicide application.
- Safe storage and handling of chemicals.
- Possible funding sources to assist land managers with on ground works.
