Brock and Katrina have got the three trial sites set up and are just waiting for machinery to become available so that they can start the work on the three sites. Due to the current drought most heavy machinery is currently being used to feed livestock. Recent significant rainfall has freed up these machines and Brock has located a machine currently not in use. They are now waiting for the ground to dry out so that they work can begin on the sites. This project is still on track to be completed within the deadline stated in the contract.

The rainfall which has fallen on Wallal has seen a significant increase in the ground cover, this can be seen in the photo site below. This site has only been destocked of all domestic animals, only natives and introduced species have been grazing on this site. This germination of seed is proof that there is a significant seed bank on this site and the rehabilitation of this site back to native pasture is well on the way.
