South West NRM's Storytelling Competition 2016

South West NRM is excited to promote this year's Storytelling Competition as part of the **2016 Charleville Performing Arts Festival** held on the **1st - 3rd September** at the Charleville Racecourse Complex. The aim of the Competition is to use story writing and storytelling to educate others, highlighting the way in which our eco-systems are degraded by releasing domestic animals and plants into the wild; either deliberately, or by accident. In order to raise awareness of the damaging effects of feral pigs in our local environment, this year's topic is *"Goin' Pigg'in"*.

Participants must orally present a story which addresses the damage caused by feral pigs, or how domestic pigs become pests when they are released or abandoned in the wild.

This year, as an alternative to a live performance, participants can choose to video themselves telling their story and nominate in a pre-recorded performance section.
